World Crafts Celebrates 20th Anniversary

September 17, 1990 was the first day of business for the Fair Trade store in Kidron, World Crafts. In those days, the handcrafted items were called "Self Help" crafts indicating that the people who made the crafts were able to provide for themselves through the sale of their handiwork.

World Crafts had its origin in Orrville with Global Treasures, which closed in 1996. Global Treasures opened a "branch outlet" inside Lehman Hardware in 1985 to sell the Self Help items. In 1990, a new shopping plaza was built in Kidron and World Crafts opened its doors. For the past 20 years, World Crafts has been a mainstay in Kidron providing the community with handcrafted home décor, gifts for weddings, graduations, retirements and birthdays, jewelry, coffee, tea & chocolate, holiday décor and musical instruments with an ethnic flair.

Lois Lehman was the manager from 1990-2007. Prior to World Crafts, she was involved in Fair Trade stores and special events since 1977. All those years were invested as a volunteer. Lisa Zuercher became manager in 2007.

World Crafts is a not for profit business whose mission is to provide a market for products produced by impoverished artisans in the developing countries of the world. In addition to selling handcrafted gifts, World Crafts donates money every year to help with community projects in the developing countries.



World Crafts and Fair Trade organizations follow the Fair Trade principles of fair pay, safe working conditions, environmental stewardship and the rights of children. Consumers have purchasing power with their dollars to make a difference in the lives of these artisans.
